

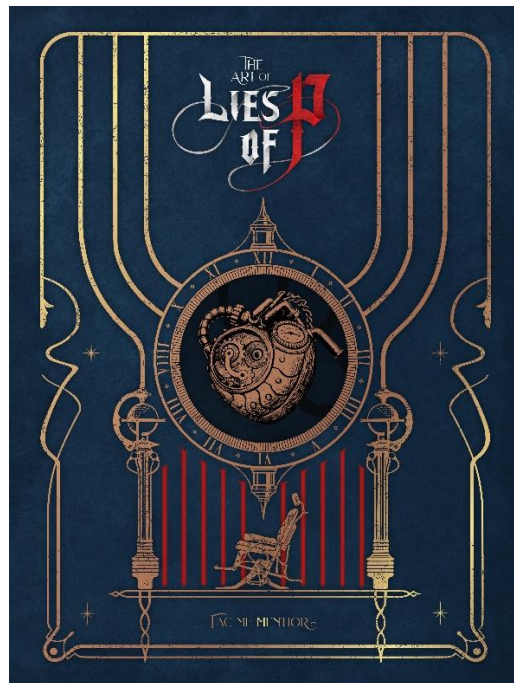
DISCOVER THE TRUTH BEHIND THE LIES IN “THE ART OF LIES OF P”
