NEW YORK (October 21, 2025) – The <u>New York Videogame Critics Circle</u> (NYVGCC) is going big for the **2026 New York Game Awards** with a two-day festival hosted at the renowned SVA Theatre in Manhattan on **Saturday, Jan. 17 and Sunday, Jan. 18**. In celebration of the awards 15th anniversary, NYVGCC is thrilled to reveal that the first night of the festival, GG Fest, will end with a worldwide exclusive **Supergiant Games: Unplugged** concert featuring award-winning composer Darren Korb and longtime collaborator Ashley Barrett.
